



George Mazzaro, 186 Eldridge Road, was opposed to the additional baseball fields because the city already has seventeen ball fields that are getting little use. Also, he said that the Director of Parks and Recreation had no legal authority to sign the application and come before the Planning Commission with this proposal.

Mr. Kraus wanted to address some of the public comments. He said that the city will only be installing gravel parking lots at this time because paved parking lots require storm water management and are cost-prohibitive. Also, there are no plans for loudspeakers or lights at this time. Regarding the comments about the baseball fields, he stated that the additional ball fields would allow for flexibility in the future because some existing fields may be eliminated. Lastly, Mr. Kraus said that the Mayor signed the conditional zoning application and he was here tonight as her staff representative.

Mrs. Grandillo asked for further comments and there were none.
